- I. Authority: DLA-D approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 1 March 1988, subject: Realignment of Management Support Activities (MSAs) to Support the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Systems) (DASD(S)).
- II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 6 March 1988, the DoD Weapon Support Improvement and Analysis Office (WSIAO) is disestablished.
- III. Paragraph III, General Order No. 4-83, dated 12 May 1983, is rescinded.
- IV. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 6 March 1988, the Management Systems Division, the Logistics Systems Modernization Division and the Program Analysis Division of the Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO) are disestablished.
- V. DSIO is realigned as an unstructured Management Support Activity with accountability to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Logistics) with responsibility for providing support for development, implementation, and management of DoD Spares Management Improvement Program (SMIP).
- VI. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 6 March 1988, the Automated Information Systems (AIS) Plans, Resources, and Requirements Division of the DoD Product Engineering Services Office (PESO) is disestablished.
- VII. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 6 March 1988, the Defense Systems Plans and Analysis Office (DSPAO) is established as an Office of Secretary of Defense Management Support Activity, with accountability to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Systems) (DASD(S)).
  - A. The Office of the Director, Weapon Systems Improvement and Analysis Division, Computer-Aided Acquisition and Logistics Support (CALS) Division, Support Systems and Technology Division, Systems Plans Division, Program Review and Analysis Division, Architecture and Technology Division, and Computer Systems Support Division are established.


