I. Authority: Assistant Secretary of Defense (Production and Logistics) memorandum, dated 21 November 1988, subject: Reorganization of Management Support Activities.


II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 4 December 1988, the Defense Spares Initiatives Office (DSIO) and the Defense Logistics Standard Systems Office (DLSSO) are disestablished.

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 4 December 1988, the Defense Logistics Support Office (DLSO) is established as an Assistant Secretary of Defense (Production and Logistics) (ASD(P&L)) Management Support Activity (MSA). Under the program accountability of the ASD(P&L) and the performance accountability of the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Logistics) (DASD(L)), DLSO shall administer the Defense Logistics Standard Systems (DLSS) and other designated standard logistics systems and programs; and administer the DoD Spares Management Improvement Program and other designated programs or processes including provisioning, cataloging, breakout, government-furnished property, and diminishing manufacturing sources. DLSO will consist of two divisions: Defense Logistics Standard Systems and Defense Logistics Initiatives. The Defense Logistics Standard Systems Division will consist of three branches: Programs and Technology, Distribution Standard Systems, and Management Standard Systems.

IV. General Orders 18-86, dated 9 June 1986, and 6-88 dated 3 March 1988, are rescinded.

V. Administrative and logistics support for DLSO will be controlled through the P&L Management Support Center (MSC) and be provided by the Commander, DLA Administrative Support Center (DASC).
