GENERAL ORDER

NO. 25-88

I. Authority: Assistant Secretary of Defense (Production and Logistics) memorandum, dated 21 November 1988, subject: Reorganization of Management Support Activities.

II. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 4 December 1988, the Defense Environmental Management Support Activity (DEMSA), an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Environment), DASD(E), is redesignated and realigned as the Defense Environmental Support Office (DESO) with a four division structure: Pollution Abatement Engineering, Environmental Planning, Hazardous Waste, and Defense Environmental Restoration Program. The DESO mission is to provide analysis, development, planning, management, coordination, implementation, and evaluation of world-wide DoD environmental programs. DESO remains an OSD Management Support Activity with program and performance accountability to the DASD(E).

III. The divisions are responsible as follows:

- a. The Pollution Abatement Engineering Division develops and coordinates guidance for DoD components in complying with the Clean Air Act, Clean Water Act, Safe Drinking Water Act, Noise Control Act and portions of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act.
- b. The Environmental Planning Division develops and coordinates guidance for DoD components with provisions in the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and directs DoD Natural Resources Conservation Programs of fish and wildlife management.
- c. The Defense Environmental Restoration Program Division manages the Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP) and the Defense Environmental Restoration Account (DERA), and maintains the Management Information System for tracking site cleanup progress.
- d. The Hazardous Waste Division serves as the central DoD source for interpretation and guidance for hazardous waste laws such as the Comprehensive Environmental Response and Compensation and Liability Act of 1980.

IV. General Order 9-87, dated 29 July 1987, is rescinded.
