GENERAL ORDER
NO. 12-90

I. Authority: DCMC approval of DLA-LPO Staff Summary Sheet dated 15 March 1990, subject: Program and Technical Support for DCMC.

II. Reference DLA General Order No. 4-90, dated 6 February 1990.

III. Pursuant to cited authority and effective 29 April 1990:

A. The Directorate of Engineering and Program Support is retitled the Directorate of Program and Technical Support. The office symbol will continue to be DLA-E.

B. The following Divisions are established as subordinate elements of the Directorate of Program and Technical Support (DLA-E):

1. Program Support and Policies Division (DLA-EP) is responsible for promoting satisfactory DCMC support to critical defense weapon systems; for development of policies relating to cost/schedule control systems criteria, value engineering and special programs; and for overall management support of the directorate.

2. Systems Engineering Division (DLA-EE) is responsible for promoting effective engineering surveillance and support to Government buying activities, especially relating to the design, development and acquisition of weapon systems and equipment.

3. Manufacturing Division (DLA-EM) is responsible for promoting effective DCMC support to Government buying activities relating to manufacturing, engineering, production, surveillance, and related status of program-managed contracts, i.e., weapon systems, related equipment, subsystems, support equipment, and associated spares.

C. The Systems and Engineering Division (DLA-AE), Directorate of Contract Management, is disestablished and its missions, functions and resources are transferred to DLA-E.

D. The Industrial Support Division (DLA-AI) is established within the Directorate of Contract Management.


E. The Production and Industrial Resources Division (DLA-AP), Directorate of Contract Management, is disestablished and its missions and functions related to surveillance, technical analysis of cost proposals (TACPs) and progress payment evaluations relating to program-managed contracts are transferred to DLA-E; its remaining missions, functions and resources are transferred to DLA-AI.

IV. General Order 9-90, dated 18 April 1990, is hereby rescinded.
