GENERAL ORDER

I. Authority: OUSD Memorandum, dated January 24, 1997, Subject: Consolidation and Centralization of the Department of Defense Cataloging Function.

II. References:

A. HQ DLA General Order No. 2-98, dated January 23, 1998 (Defense Logistics Services Center (DLSC) is renamed Defense Logistics Information Service (DLIS)).

B. OUSD Memorandum, dated March 25, 1997, Subject: Consolidation and Centralization of the Department of Defense Cataloging Function.

III. Pursuant to cited authority, the DoD cataloging function is consolidated and centralized under the management and direction of DLA. The cataloging workload, mission, and associated resources of the Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps and the Defense Special Weapons Agency (DSWA) will transfer to the Defense Logistics Information Service (DLIS), Battle Creek, MI.

IV. Additionally, the cataloging workload and associated resources from the Defense Supply Center Columbus (DSCC), Defense Supply Center Richmond (DSCR), Defense Industrial Supply Center (DISC), and Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP) will realign to DLIS. A business plan will be developed in the future, between DLSC and DLIS, which will address the issue of transfer of HQ DLA cataloging policy to DLIS.

V. The transfers and realignments will occur in phases over the next three fiscal years (FY 98-FY 00), with transfer dates being mutually agreed to by DLIS, the Services, Defense Supply Centers and DSWA.

VI. Administrative support will continue to be provided under the current arrangements at DLIS.
