**GENERAL ORDER**

NO. 11-99

June 7, 1999

**I. AUTHORITY:** Decision by the Director, DLA on November 10, 1998.

**II. REFERENCE:** HQ DLA General Order No. 32-98, dated December 22, 1998.

**III.** Pursuant to cited authority and effective June 1, 1999, three Business Support Units (BSUs) are established as field elements reporting to the Executive Director, Information Systems & Technology, Defense Logistics Support Command (DLSC). A BSU is a semi-autonomous DLA field activity performing centralized support functions. The BSUs receive an annual operating budget and maintain fiduciary responsibility for that budget, which may include responsibility for their own performance plan, and FTE and budget execution.

A. The DLA Systems Integration Office for Distribution and Base Support BSU (DSIO-U) is established in Ogden, UT, to maintain the Distribution Standard System (DSS), Deployable Medical Systems (DEPMEDS), Base Operations Support Systems (BOSS), Management Information System (MIS), Distribution Information System (DIS), Equipment Management and Control System (EMACS), and Safety and Health Information and Reporting System (SHIRS). The mission, objectives and resources (including FTEs and funding) responsible for maintaining, designing, developing, testing and deploying these systems, and the ancillary systems in support of these distribution systems, are transferred from the DLA Systems Design Center Transition Management Office (TMO) to DSIO-U. The DSIO-U consists of the following divisions:

1. DSS Shipping and Transportation (DSIO-UA)
2. Equipment Control Systems (DSIO-UB)
3. DSS MRO Processing/Workload Planning and Receiving (DSIO-UC)
4. DSS MIS/DIS/DEPMEDS/BOSS and Legacy Distribution (DSIO-UD)
5. Environmental Systems, EMACS and SHIRS (DSIO-UE)
6. Technical and Data Base Management (DSIO-UF)

B. The DLA Systems Integration Office for Materiel Management Systems BSU (DSIO-M) is established in Columbus, OH, to maintain the DLA Materiel Management Systems, specifically the Standard Automated Material Management System (SAMMS), Defense Integrated Subsistence Management System (DISMS) and Defense Fuels Automated Management System (DFAMS). The mission, objectives and resources (including FTEs and funding) responsible for maintaining, designing, developing, testing and deploying these systems, and the ancillary systems in support of these materiel management systems are transferred from the DLA Systems Design Center TMO to DSIO-M. The DSIO-M BSU consists of the following divisions:

1. DISMS Product Manager (DSIO-MD)
2. Energy Product Manager (DSIO-ME)
3. SAMMS Product Manager (DSIO-MS)



C. The DLA Systems Integration Office for Logistics Systems BSU (DSIO-J) is established in Battle Creek, MI, to plan, coordinate and administer the direction, focus and integration of Information Resources Management and Automated Information Systems initiatives supporting its customers. The mission, objectives and resources (including FTEs and funding) responsible for providing policy and procedural guidance, configuration management, technical and administrative support to all aspects of the Logistics Information Management resources functions are transferred from the DLA Systems Design Center TMO to DSIO-J. The DSIO-J BSU consists of the following divisions:

1. DAISY Product Development (DSIO-JA)
2. FLIS Product Development (DSIO-JB)
3. Systems Management (DSIO-JC)

IV. Administrative support will be provided by current sources or through reimbursable Interservice Support agreements.
